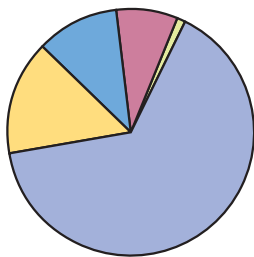
## MISSION STATEMENT

Coburn Place opens a door through which women and children fleeing domestic violence can find safe haven. Coburn Place transforms battered lives by healing painful emotions, teaching valuable life skills, and fostering financial independence and long-term self-sufficiency.

Coburn Place is located in the Meridian Kessler neighborhood; and services domestic violence survivors from throughout central Indiana. Coburn Place is located in the former Henry P. Coburn IPS #66 and is on the National Register of Historic Places.

## GOALS

Coburn Place breaks the cycle of domestic violence through its comprehensive and long-term program. While living at Coburn Place, domestic violence survivors can heal from abuse, learn new skills,

build financial stability and, eventually, secure permanent and sustainable housing. Coburn Place offers residents two years of safe, transitional housing (in one of the 35 apartment homes) and effective sup-

portive services. Coburn Place improves the community by reducing incidents of homelessness and domestic violence, teaching financial management skills, and by increasing families' self-sufficiency.

Donations to Coburn Place change lives and are tax-deductible. Donations can be made by phone, by mail, or at [www.coburnplace.org](http://www.coburnplace.org). **\$500** provides housing for a month for a Coburn Place family; **\$1,000** provides a month of bus passes for residents working toward self-sufficiency; **\$3,000** provides 12 residents with therapy for one month; **\$6,000** heats Coburn Place's 58,000+ square feet facility for three months; and **\$10,000** provides six weeks of advocacy and support to 35 residents.
